



## Year 3 Art - Drawing (including digital)

### Vocabulary:

**Digital Art** - a type of art but instead of using paints and brushes, you use tools in a painting software program

**Pointillism** - A type of painting that makes a picture using lots of colourful dots.

**Cubism** - A style of art where shapes are overlapped to make a picture of something

**Abstract Art** - A style of art that uses shapes, lines and colours to create an image.

**Symmetry** - Copy an object or picture to make it the same on both sides.

**Tool** - An item that can be used to create a digital painting.



### Year 3 Groblov (digital focus):

Artist suggestion: *Children's digital art pieces inspired by Mondrian, Sarah Morris and Josef Albers*

**Y3D1:** I can use a simple graphics package to create images and effects.

## Year 3 Art - Painting (including printing)

### Vocabulary:

**Tint** - A tint is a colour mixed with white.

**Texture** - Texture is the look and feel of a surface.

**Mood** - Mood in art is defined by the emotions that are elicited in the viewer of a piece of artwork, intentionally or unintentionally.

**Blend** - It is the technique of gently combining two or more colours to soften lines.

**Direction** - It's the way the brush moves to build image

**Ferrule** - connects the brush head to the handle

**Strokes** - Paints left on a surface by a single application



### Year 3 Groblox:

Artist suggestion: Yellena James

Black Groblox - skill **Red Groblox**- knowledge

**Y3P1:** I can use watercolour paint to produce washes for backgrounds then add detail.

**Y3P2:** I can experiment with tools and techniques e.g. layering, mixing media, scraping through.

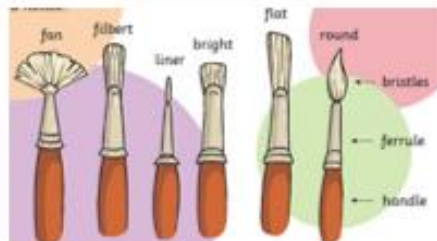
**Y3P3:** I can mix and use tints and shades of secondary colours.

## Year 3 Art - Sculpture (including form)

### Vocabulary:

**Collage** - A piece of art made by sticking various different materials such as photographs and pieces of paper or fabric on to a backing.

**Fold** - Pinching the edge of paper or card to change the shape.

**Overlapping** - When shapes are in front of other shapes. If one shape overlaps another it communicates an illusion of depth.

**Texture** - The physical appearance or feel of an object, and can be seen through bumps, ridges, grooves and other physical details.



### Year 3 Groblox (collage):

Artist suggestion: Henri Matisse

Black Groblox - skill **Red Groblox**- knowledge

**Y3S1:** I can experiment with a range of collage techniques such as tearing and layering to create 3D images and represent textures.

**Y3S2:** I can experiment with sorting and arranging materials to refine my artwork.

**Y3S3:** I can clearly explain my thoughts and opinions of Artists works using key vocabulary.

### Previous Groblox:

**Y2S2:** I can add texture to the surface of a malleable material such as clay slabs using recycled, natural and manmade objects eg pasta, leaves, sticks, ~~card~~, plastic letters, bottle tops etc

**Y2S3:** I can recall how Artists have created a sculpture using natural materials.

## Year 3 Art - Photography

### Vocabulary:

**Reflection** - an image seen in a mirror or shiny surface.

**Viewfinder** - a device on a camera showing a field of view through the lens.

**Exclude** - leave something out.

**Lens** - a piece of glass with curved sides for concentrating light.

**Flash** - a bright, brief and sudden light.

**Memory Card** - a device to store digital data such as photographs

**Battery** - a cell used as a source of power.



### Year 3 Groblox:

Artist suggestion: *Florence Henri*

Black Groblox - skill **Red Groblox**- knowledge

**Y3PH1:** I can photograph reflections in puddles, windows or mirrors.

**Y3PH2:** I can use a viewfinder such as fingers or cardboard frame to decide what to include or exclude in my picture.

**Y3PH3:** I can name 3 different parts of a camera.

### Previous Groblox:

**Y2PH1:** I can use a grid onscreen to place an object using the Rule of Thirds

**Y2PH3:** I know that photographs can be edited using basic digital tools.
