



Vocabulary:

Leaves: Catch sunlight to make food

Stem: Holds the plant up. Carries water and nutrients from the roots to the leaves and flowers

Roots: Take in water and nutrients from the soil. Holds the plant in the ground

Flower/Petals: Attracts insects and birds

Temperature: How warm or cold something

is

Germinate: When a seed or bulb first starts

to grow

Seeds & Bulbs: Plants grow from these and they have a store of food inside them





Observe: To look very carefully

Record: To write down

S2P3: I can write careful observations about how a plant changes during growth


