Term 1: The children will have PE on a Tuesday and a Thursday.

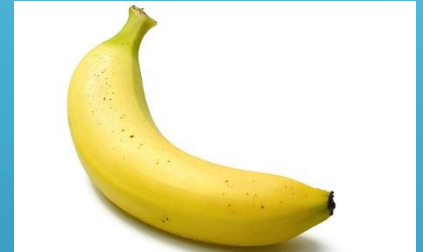
Swimming will be in Term 5 (w/c 20.04.26).

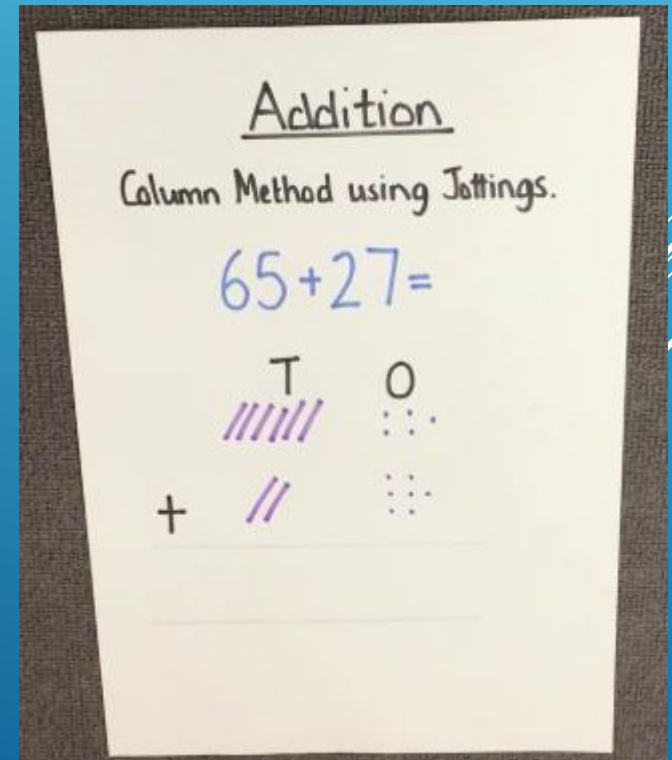
