Vocabulary:

Web crawlers - A web crawler, or spider, is a type of bot that is typically operated by search engines like Google and Bing. Their purpose is to index the content of websites all across the Internet so that those websites can appear in search engine results.

Rank – to put in a certain order.

Previous Vocabulary:

Data Packet – information sent from one computer to another.

Hyperlink – a link that takes a user to another document, or web page, or to another part of a document.

Online – on the internet.

Internet - a network, or system, that connects millions of computers worldwide.

Computer network - A group of interconnected computing devices.

Search engine – Computer software used to help people find the information they are looking for – e.g. Google.

Server - A networked computer that manages, stores, and provides data such as files to other computers.

Web server - A powerful computer, like a PC in a building somewhere. Your web browser can connect to it, to download text and images.

World Wide Web (WWW) – A system of interconnected public webpages accessible through the Internet.

Vocabulary:

Action – the process of doing an operation, or following an instruction.

Consequence – the result or effect of doing an operation or following an instruction.

List – a series of connected items.

Path – this allows you to create a 'journey' for your graphic within a piece of software.

Test – to run the program or set of commands to check how well (if at all) the code works.

User – the person who uses a program or application.

Previous Vocabulary:

Algorithm – a set of steps or instructions.

Code – a set of instructions for a computer.

Command – an instruction given to an object or character to make something happen.

Debug – detect and correct errors in programs.

Variable – A named piece of data (often a number or text) stored in a computer's memory, which can be accessed and changed by a computer program.

Random variable - A variable whose value is unknown, i.e. a number chosen by chance like rolling a dice.

Flat-file databases – Year 5, Term 3, Learning Organiser

Vocabulary:

Field – a specific area in a database where you enter data. It's essentially a place where you can store information, such as a name or an address in a form.

Record – A record is a collection of fields, possibly of different data types, typically in a fixed number and sequence.

Real-world database – real-world database means real-life examples of databases, such as: healthcare systems, online banking systems, hotel booking systems, airline reservation systems, etc.

Previous Vocabulary:

Data - A letter, word, number etc. that has been collected for a purpose, but stored without context

Data set - A collection of related data


