



Vocabulary:

I.P. Address - An IP (*Internet Protocol*) address is a network address for your computer, so the internet knows where to send your emails and data.

Packet - A packet is a small segment of a larger message. Data sent over computer networks, such as the Internet, is divided into packets.

Previous Vocabulary:

Computer network - A group of interconnected computing devices.

Internet - a network, or system, that connects millions of computers worldwide.

Wireless access point WAP (router) - A device that manages the flow of data between computer networks.

Search engine - Computer software used to help people find the information they are looking for – e.g. Google.

Switch (network switch) - A device that manages the flow of data packets within a computer network.

Server - A networked computer that manages, stores, and provides data such as files to other computers.

Web server - A powerful computer, like a PC in a building somewhere. Your web browser can connect to it, to download text and images.

World Wide Web (WWW) - A system of interconnected public webpages accessible through the Internet.

Wireless Network (Wi-Fi) - a computer network that uses wireless data connections between network devices (nodes).

IP Addresses: An Overview

IP addresses are unique identifiers assigned to internet-connected devices, and they're required for your device to access the internet.

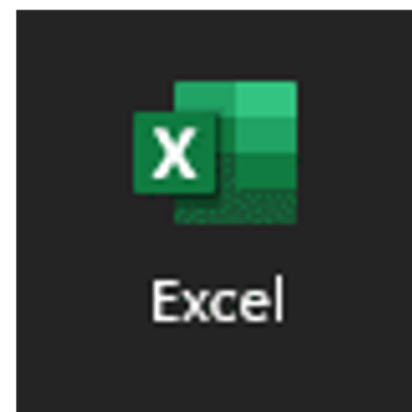

Conditional loop - A conditional loop tells a computer to repeat a sequence of actions until a condition is satisfied.

Microcontroller - A Computer in Miniature - They contain all of the core components that make up any modern digital computer – a central processing unit (CPU), memory and some form of data input and output.

Micro:bit - The BBC micro:bit is a pocket-sized computer. It has an LED light display, buttons, sensors and many input/output features that you can program and physically interact with.

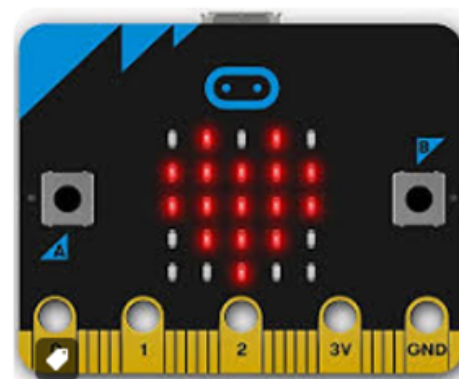
