### Vocabulary:

**I.P. Address** - An IP (*Internet Protocol*) address is a network address for your computer, so the internet knows where to send your emails and data.

**Packet** - A packet is a small segment of a larger message. Data sent over computer networks, such as the Internet, is divided into packets.

#### Previous Vocabulary:

**Computer network** - A group of interconnected computing devices.

**Internet** - a network, or system, that connects millions of computers worldwide.

**Wireless access point WAP (router)** - A device that manages the flow of data between computer networks.

**Search engine** – Computer software used to help people find the information they are looking for – e.g. Google.

**Switch (network switch)** - A device that manages the flow of data packets within a computer network.

**Server** - A networked computer that manages, stores, and provides data such as files to other computers.

**Web server** - A powerful computer, like a PC in a building somewhere. Your web browser can connect to it, to download text and images.

**World Wide Web (WWW)** – A system of interconnected public webpages accessible through the Internet.

**Wireless Network (Wi-Fi)** - a computer network that uses wireless data connections between network devices (nodes).

## BBC Microbits - Year 6, Term 4, Learning Organiser

### Vocabulary:

**Infinite loop** - sometimes called an endless loop - is a piece of code that repeats indefinitely.

**Conditional loop** - A conditional loop tells a computer to repeat a sequence of actions until a condition is satisfied.

**Microcontroller** - A Computer in Miniature - They contain all of the core components that make up any modern digital computer – a central processing unit (CPU), memory and some form of data input and output.

**Micro:bit** - The BBC micro:bit is a pocket-sized computer. It has an LED light display, buttons, sensors and many input/output features that you can program and physically interact with.


