We are looking forward to our school sports days, next week. The events will take place on the following dates:

This year, due to the extensive building work taking place on our school site, our sports days will be held at St John's CofE Primary.

For those unfamiliar with the location of the school, I attach a **map** with the walking route from St Keyna to the entrance to St John's along with a map of the school site to show the location of the activities on the school field.

PLEASE NOTE: There will be no access to toilet facilities for any spectators during the sports day. In addition, please do not arrive more than 5 minutes before the start time as we want to minimise disruption caused to St John's. Can you also remember not to take any photos or film of the event as some children cannot be photographed for safeguarding reasons.

Please ensure that the children wear their PE kits in school for sports day, including an appropriate pair of shoes for physical activity.

If your child is in Key Stage 2 (Sapphire, Jade, Topaz or Amber), they will also need a t-shirt which matches the colour of their school house which are as follows:

Water = blue

Air = yellow

Fire = red

Earth = green

Should your child not have a t-shirt which matches the colour of their house, we have a limited supply of coloured bibs that they can wear over their white PE tops.

They will also need their water bottle in school to ensure they keep hydrated. If it looks like it is going to be a particularly hot day, we would encourage you to apply sun cream to your child before coming to school and ensure they have a sun hat.

We look forward to sharing these events with you again this year and have our fingers crossed for perfect weather!

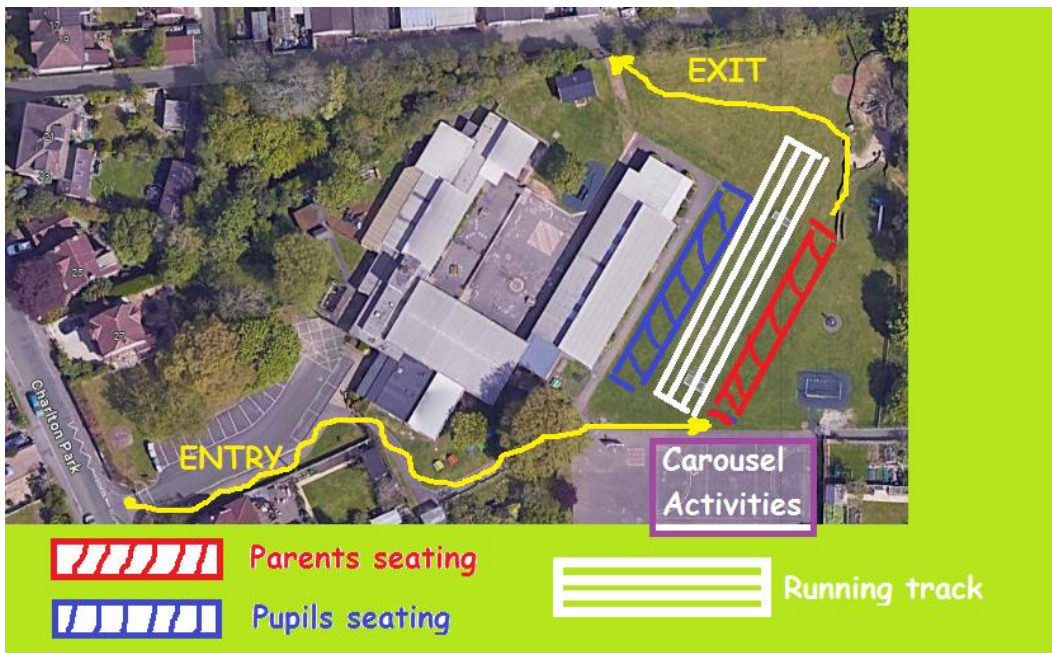
