# Vocabulary:

Same – matching, alike

**Different** – not the same as another or each other.

Modern – present or recent times

Old – having been around for a long time

Invention – creating something new

Timeline – a line that shows the order in time that things happened

Relatives – people from a family, e.g. parents, brothers, sisters, grandparents, aunts, uncles, cousins...

**Chalkboard** - a dark surface on a wall or frame on which you write with chalk sometimes called a blackboard.

**Decade:** 10 years

**Century:** 100 years


