

Sequence – an order of events.

PEGI (Pan-European Game Information)

- a European video game content rating system established to help people make informed decisions when buying video games or apps through the use of age recommendations and content descriptors.

Previous Vocabulary:

Program – to create a sequence of instructions (code) for a computer.

Command – an instruction given to an object or character to make something happen.

Code – a set of instructions for a computer.

Debug – to make our code better (removing the bugs/faults).

Algorithm – a set of steps or instructions.

Predict – work out what will happen.
