Sports Arrangements:

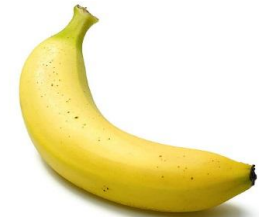
Term 1: PE is on a Tuesday afternoon, children should wear their PE kits into school.

Hair longer than shoulder length should be tied back.

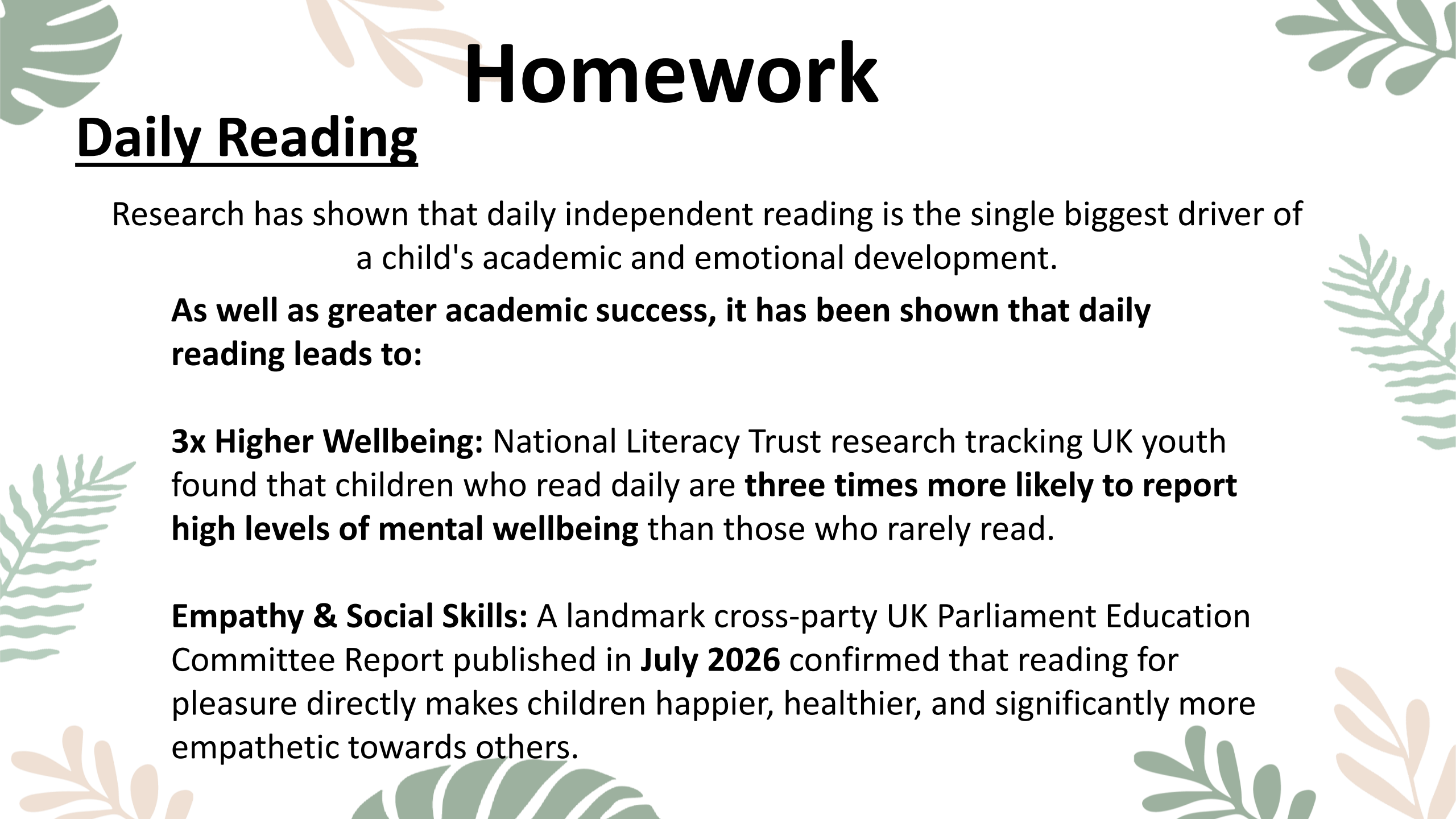




Children should not be bringing any toys, stickers or cards into school.

Homework

Daily Reading

Research has shown that daily independent reading is the single biggest driver of a child's academic and emotional development.

As well as greater academic success, it has been shown that daily reading leads to:

3x Higher Wellbeing: National Literacy Trust research tracking UK youth found that children who read daily are **three times more likely to report high levels of mental wellbeing** than those who rarely read.

Empathy & Social Skills: A landmark cross-party UK Parliament Education Committee Report published in **July 2026** confirmed that reading for pleasure directly makes children happier, healthier, and significantly more empathetic towards others.
