



Year 5 Art - Drawing (including digital)

Vocabulary:

Digital Art - a type of art but instead of using paints and brushes, you use tools in a painting software program.

Art Style - An art style describes the visual elements that define how an artwork appears.

Scaling - The physical size of an artwork or objects in the artwork.

Typography - The style and appearance of printed matter

Graphics - Visual images produced by computer processing.

Exploratory - Relating to or involving exploration.

Printing - repeating the same image.

Year 5 Art - Painting (including printing)

Vocabulary:

Tertiary - The combination of primary and secondary colours.

Portrait - A painting, drawing, photograph, or engraving of a person, especially one depicting only the face or head and shoulders.

Landscape - Denoting a format of printed matter which is wider than it is high.

Abstract - An art that does not attempt to represent an accurate depiction of a visual reality but instead use shapes and colours etc.

Canvas - A heavy, closely woven fabric, that painters are painted on.

Palette - A board on which an artist mixes paints.

Black Groblox - skill Red Groblox- knowledge

Y5P1: I can use complementary and contrasting colours in my art work.

Year 5 Art - Sculpture (including form)

Vocabulary:

Collage - A piece of art made by sticking various different materials such as photographs and pieces of paper or fabric on to a backing.

Coiling - Strips of paper are coiled around a cylindrical tool to create a coil, and then stuck down.

Overlapping - When shapes are in front of other shapes. If one shape overlaps another it communicates an illusion of depth.

Tessellation - A repeating pattern made of shapes that has no gaps.

Mosaic - The decoration of a surface with small, variously coloured pieces of material such as paper, glass, stone.

Texture - The physical appearance or feel of an object, and can be seen through bumps, ridges, grooves and other physical details.

Arrangement - How artists organize shapes, colours, lines, and other components to create a cohesive and impactful piece.

Y5S2: I can produce an outcome that includes at least two different collage techniques. This could include; coiling, overlapping, tessellation, mosaic and montage.


Y5S3: I can add collage to a painted, printed or drawn background.

Year 5 Art - Photography

Vocabulary:

Portrait - a painting, drawing or photograph of a person

Landscape - a painting, drawing or photograph of an area of land

Edit - to change or correct something.

Software - a set of instructions that tells a device what to do and how to do it.

Crop - to cut something

Adjust - to alter or move something slightly to create a different appearance

Brightness - how much light an object gives out

Composition - the way in which a whole or mixture is made up.

Layer - a thickness of material, often one of several, covering a surface.

Weave - threads passing in one direction with other at a right angle to them.
