Tone - how light or dark something is.


Observe - Looking at something as we draw it.

Design - The process of thinking about different ideas and choosing a final one.

Work of Art - A piece of art work created by an individual.

Year 2 Art - Painting (including printing)

Vocabulary:

Tint - A tint is a colour mixed with white.

Shade - A mixture of pure colours to which only black is added.

Dab - A dab is the motion with which you pat or apply something to a surface.

Texture - Texture is the look and feel of a surface.

Y2P2: I can create textured paint by adding sand, flour, salt etc.


Y2P3: I can hold my paintbrush correctly in order to control my marks when working on different scales.

Y1P3: I can identify primary and secondary colours by name.


Y1P5: I able to make comparisons between my own work and that of an artist.

Year 2 Art - Sculpture (including form)

Vocabulary:

Natural materials - Made from things that live on or are from our world- e.g. wood.

Sculpture - The art of making something using moulding or carving.

Geometric - Using known shapes to create a sculpture.

Intertwine - connect or link (two or more things) closely.

Observe - paying attention to details such as shapes, colours, textures, and proportions in the natural world or others art.

Black Groblox - skill **Red Groblox- knowledge**

Y2S1: I can create images such as leaves on different scales from a variety of media using magazines, crepe paper, textured paper, fabric etc.

Y2S2: I can add texture to the surface of a malleable material such as clay slabs using recycled, natural and manmade objects e.g. pasta, leaves, sticks, Lego, plastic letters, bottle tops etc

Y2S3: I can manipulate malleable materials in a variety of ways including rolling, pinching, kneading and shaping.

Y2S4: I can recall how Artists have created a sculpture using

Year 2 Art - Photography

Vocabulary:


Rule of Thirds - a grid that helps place an object in either the left or right third of a picture, leaving the other two thirds blank.

Series - a number of events, people or objects with a similar theme, e.g. toys or children

Sequence - a particular order in which things follow each other.

Grid - a framework of evenly spaced lines or bars

Black Groblox - skill **Red Groblox**- knowledge

Y2PH1: I can use a grid onscreen to place an object using the Rule of Thirds

Y2PH2: I can take a series of photographs to show a sequence of events e.g. 'A Day in the Life of a Toy' or 'Building a Tower from Lego'.

Y2PH3: I know that photographs can be edited using basic digital tools.
