*Little Gems, if a Monday morning is not your usual session, you are welcome to join us for Sports Day!

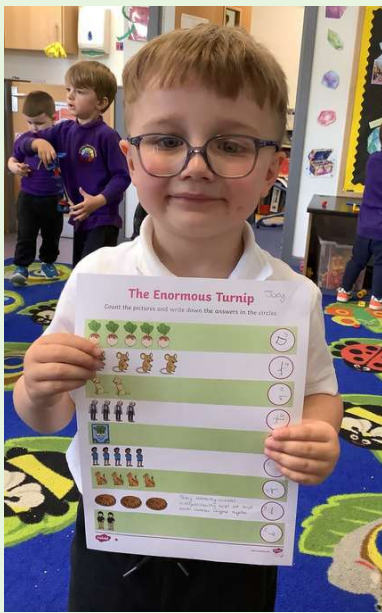

Lucas - pumpkins

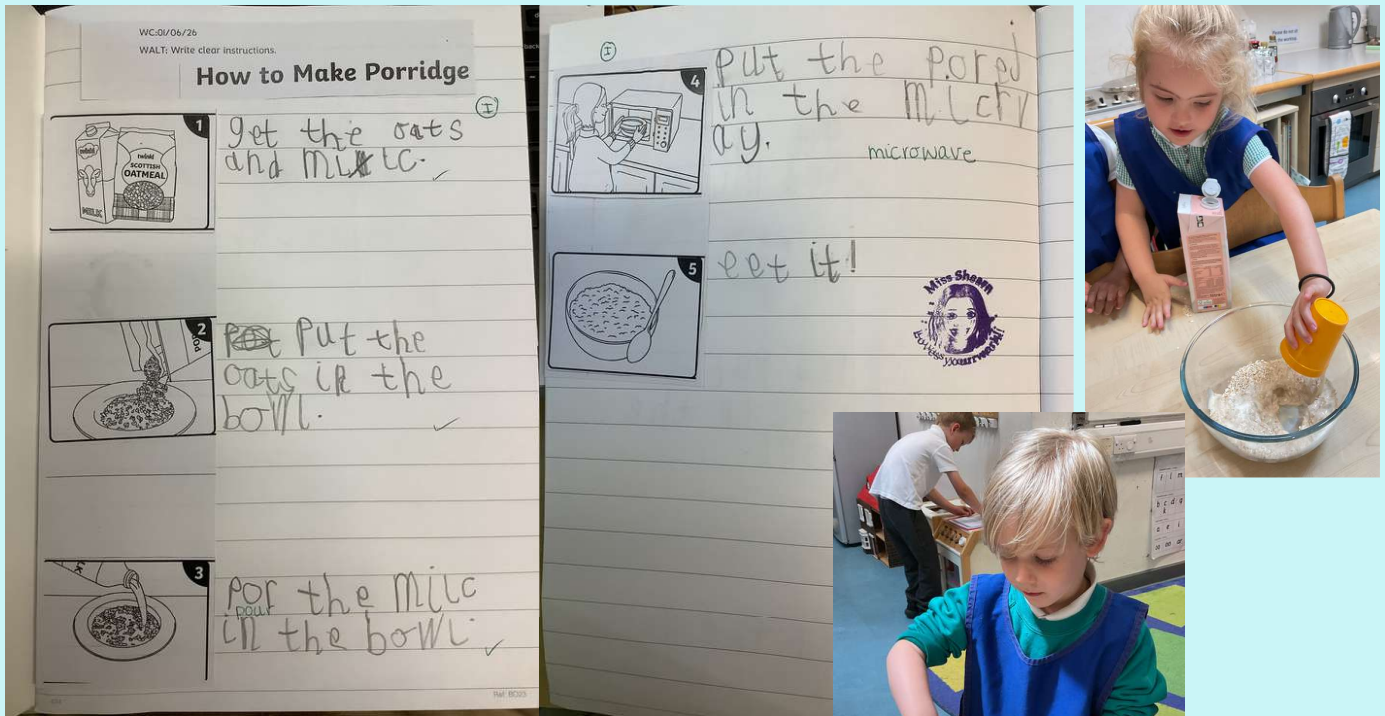

RECEPTION

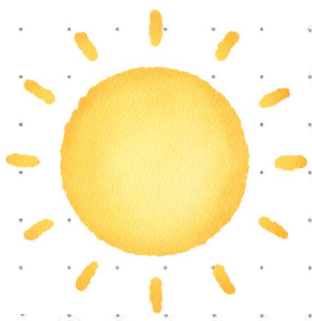
In Reception, the traditional tales we have done so far are 'Goldilocks and the Three Bears' and 'The Gingerbreadman'!

SUN SAFETY IN EYFS

HATS

Now the weather is warming up, please make sure all children have a suitable sun hat to wear outside.

All hats **MUST** be clearly labelled to avoid being lost or mixed up.



WATER BOTTLES

Please make sure children come to school with a water bottle each day. The students have access to their bottles the whole day and we are able to refill them if needed.

SUN CREAM

Please apply suncream to your child in the morning before coming to school. Most sun creams last for the duration of the school day, however, if your child needs to bring suncream to school, please make sure it is child friendly and they can apply it themselves. Any suncream coming to school must be labelled and handed to your class teacher or TA to ensure it is used correctly and not shared with other children.



SUNGLASSES

Children are welcome to bring sunglasses to school to protect their eyes. These must have proper protection (not just decorative!) and must also be clearly labelled.
