Vocabulary:

Perspective - How 3D objects appear in a 2D space (similar to drawing something 3D on a 2D piece of paper).

Negative Space - The empty space around and between the subject of an image.

Grid Method - A method used to enlarge images. Scaling up Increase the size.

Structure - The way in which work of art is formed.

Landscape - all the visible features of an area of land.

Perspective - a method of creating the illusion of depth by using lines that get closer together.

Scale - the size of one object in relation to the other objects.

Proportion - the size of the parts of an object in relationship to other parts of the same object.

Tone - providing a range of light to dark by shading with pencil.



Year 6 Art - Painting (including printing)

Vocabulary:

Geometric shapes- Geometric shapes are shapes made out of points and lines including the triangle, square, and circle

Abstract - A non-lifelike portrayal of real-world objects, people and scenes

Printing block- Printing technique that uses a carved material (typically wood, linoleum, or rubber) to transfer ink onto fabric or paper.

Relief printing- when you carve into a printing block that you then use to press onto paper and make a print.

Impressed printing - Impressed printing is drawing into paint using combs, scrapers, forks, etc.

Collagraphy-A printmaking process in which materials are glued or sealed to a rigid substrate (such as paperboard or wood) to create a plate.

Screen printing - A process where ink is forced through a mesh screen onto a surface.

Overlay - To overlay something is to put something on a surface to cover it.

Year 6 Art - Photography

Vocabulary:

Manipulate - altering an image to change its appearance

Image - the representation of the external form of a being or thing in art.

Selective - affecting some things and not others

Technique - a way of carrying out a particular task.

Filter - a digital or physical tool designed to alter the appearance of something.

Post-Production - work done after the photograph has been taken

Composition - the way in which a whole or mixture is made up.

Year 6 Art - Sculpture (including form)

Vocabulary:

Structure - The arrangement of the body, object or model.

Texture - How an object looks or feels

Form - The shape, structure, and arrangement of components like length, width and depth of a shape.

Influence - Being inspired by another artist or a piece of work so that you want to use their ideas or techniques.

Hollow - A form that is not filled e.g. a straw is hollow because it has no centre.

Template - A shape showing the fit of an object or model.

Cast - Wrapped plaster that has hardened to protect its insides.

Wire - A material that can be shaped into a thin structure.
