Vocabulary:

Judaism-the religion of the Jewish people.

Jewish- connected to Jews and their traditions.

Synagogue - A synagogue is a Jewish house of worship. A synagogue, is for Jews what a church is for Christians, or a mosque for Muslims, or a temple for Hindus.

Israel-a country in south west Asia on the Mediterranean Sea.

Shabbat-the Jewish day of rest.

Mezuzah-a small case with a bible reference on parchment inside, attached to the doorpost of a Jewish home.

Hebrew- the official language of Israel.

Torah-the sacred scrolls including the first 5 books of the Bible.

Inspire – to stimulate or influence by giving ideas.

Sikh – someone who believes in one God who they call Waheguru.

Waheguru – the name of the supreme being in the Sikh religion.

Guru Nanak – also known as Bābā Nānak ('Father Nānak'), was an Indian spiritual teacher and poet, who is regarded as the founder of Sikhism.

Ghandi – an Indian lawyer, politician, social activist and writer who became the leader of the Indian Independence Movement against British rule.

Desmond Tutu – a South African Anglican bishop.

4R7: I understand Sikhs are inspired by Guru Nanak.

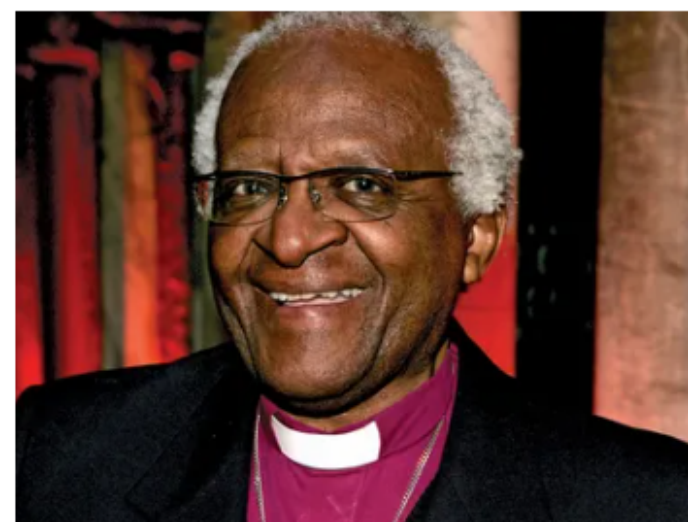
Previous Groblox:

RE Year 4- Terms 5&6 - What does it mean to belong to a religion? HINDUISM

Vocabulary:

Hindu-someone who follows Hinduism.

Hinduism- the main religion of India which has many deities of the one supreme being Brahman.

Brahman/Brahma-the supreme God in Hinduism.

Mandir (temple) - a place of worship for Hindus.

Vishnu-the God of preservation.

Shiva-the God of destruction.

Ganesha-the remover of obstacles.

Diwali-the Hindu festival of light.

Holi-the festival of colours, love and Spring.

Karma - the effect of every action we make.

Samsara-the cycle of birth-life-death repeated.
