



Year 5 RE- Terms 1&2 - Why do religious books and teachings matter?

Vocabulary:

The Trinity-the three separate forms that God is known by.

Gospel-the record of Christ's life and teaching.

Revelation-the way in which God reveals himself.

Covenant-a written agreement between two parties.

The Ten Commandments-ten rules given by God for people to live by.

Lent-the 40 days leading up to Easter. Christians often give something up for Lent.

Sanskrit is an ancient Indian language.

The Vedas - a collection of hymns praising the Vedic gods. Veda means 'knowledge'.

The Ramayana - long epic poems about Rama and Sita.

The Mahabharata - which includes the story of Rama and Sita.

The Puranas - a collection of stories about the different incarnations and the lives of saints.

5R2: I can give two examples of how to live a good moral life linking each experience to a relevant bible story e.g. The Good Samaritan-being a kind person although you may not be best friends.

5R3: I understand that there are many holy scriptures that are important to Hindus, such as the Vedas, the Puranas and many others.

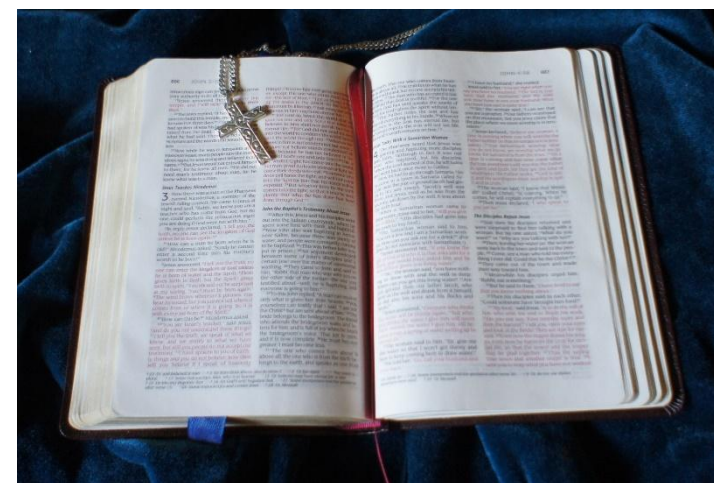
Previous Groblox:

Year 5 RE – Terms 3&4 -Why are some journeys and places special?

Vocabulary:

Journey- a long trip from one place to another.

Respect-to admire and have regard for.

Pilgrimage-a long trip made to a holy place for religious reasons.

Pilgrim-someone who takes a trip to a holy place for religious reasons.

Quest-to search or hunt for something.

Islam-a religion whose holy book is the Koran/Qu'ran.

Muslim-someone who follows the religion of Islam.

Haj-a sacred pilgrimage which is required of every Muslim at least once in their lifetime.

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Year 5 RE – Terms 5&6 - How do we make moral choices?

Vocabulary:

Moral duty- to have good and honest behaviour.

Moral dilemma-a situation in which a difficult decision has to be made in which you have two courses of action.

Hindu deities-the gods and goddesses in Hinduism.

Brahman - a term used by Hindus to describe God or the Supreme Being.

Navratri - when Hindus celebrate the Divine Power they believe is available to all of us (not just Hindus) in whichever form is best for us.

Devis - female deities: Lakshmi, Saraswati and Durga/Parvati

The Ramayana-the Hindu story of Rama and Sita.

Self-discipline-a control of oneself.

Symbolism-the symbolic meaning of a thing or event.

The Vedas - Hinduism's holy books. There are four main books: Rig Veda, Sama Veda, Yajur Veda, and Atharva Veda.

Groblox:

5R8: I can explain the nature of God in Hinduism.

5R9: I can explain how having good morals can help people make the right choices and use a parable to explain this, e.g. The Good Samaritan.

5R10: I can describe how good morals win over evil in the Ramayana and write an example.
